RULES

1. The Laws of the game shall apply with the exceptions of Laws 1 (Field of Play), 3 (Number of Players), 7 (Duration of Play) and 11 (Offside).

2. Each school shall be represented by a squad of eight players. Two substitutes may be used by each team during a game. Substitutes may be used at any time during the game with the permission of the referee in accordance with Law 3. Entry to the Field of Play will only be allowed during a stoppage in the game. A player who has been replaced may return to the playing area as a substitute for another player.
3. A size 4 ball will be used. **Each school is to provide such a ball, clearly marked with the name of the school.**
4. Each match, including the Final, will have a duration of 6 minutes each way, with teams changing round immediately at halftime.
5. (a) In the League sections, a win will gain 3 points and a draw 1 point. Should teams share a position in the League the position shall be decided on goal difference. Should points and goal difference be equal, the winners shall be the team scoring the most goals. If this fails to determine the positions, the positions will be decided by kicks taken from the penalty mark, in accordance with the recommendations of F.I.F.A.
(b) If teams are level at the end of normal time in the knock-out section of the Competition, play will continue for a further 6 minutes, 3 minutes each way. If this fails to determine the winning team, the position will be decided by kicks taken from the penalty mark, in accordance with the recommendations of F.I.F.A.
6. **Teams with more than one set of shirts are requested to bring a change of shirts.** If the referee decides that there is a colour clash the first named team will change.
